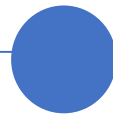

The Australian Education Research Organisation (AERO) is Australia's new independent education evidence body, established and funded by federal, state and territory governments.

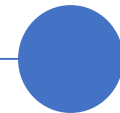
AERO's vision is for excellence and equity in educational outcomes for all children and young people through effective use of evidence. In support of this vision, we:

All of AERO's work is underpinned by our overall vision of achieving excellence and equity in educational outcomes through effective use of evidence. Some examples of projects:

Promoting the science of learning and development

Establish guidance on quality instruction for schools rooted in the science of learning and aligned to relevant national frameworks to ensure that every student in every classroom in Australia is receiving quality teaching that aligns with how the human brain learns

Implementing effective tiered interventions in secondary schools

Undertake primary research and develop practical resources to support lower secondary school practitioners to implement effective targeted literacy and numeracy interventions. This will work to minimise the learning gap between students in early secondary school and improve educational outcomes for key disadvantaged cohorts.

Improving outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children and young people

Work with our First Nations Expert Reference Group to focus on culturally responsive teaching and representation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the teaching workforce to ensure all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children feel valued and welcomed at school
